Discuss Proposal to Rebuild a Portion of Secondary 203 Near Stevensville, MT

The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) will discuss the proposal to rebuild about 5.8 miles of Secondary 203 (Eastside Highway) between Stevensville and Florence, MT., in Ravalli County. The project begins at Reference Post (RP) 4.0, about 3.7 miles north of Stevensville. It extends northerly 5.8 miles to RP 10.1, about 0.2 miles south of Hidden Valley Road.

The project proposes to reconstruct the road to a 44-ft. top width that provides two 12-foot travel lanes, a 12-foot center/left turn lane, and two 4-foot shoulders. Roadside slopes and ditches will be revised to improve safety. The vertical alignment and drainage features will be upgraded throughout the project. The 90° horizontal curves at Rathbun Lane and Ambrose Creek Road will also be flattened for safety. The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of the project status and solicit public input.

The meeting is open to the public and will be recorded. MDT attempts to provide accommodations for any known disability that may interfere with a person's participation in any department service, program or activity.
